Ed Stockham was a professor at RIT for approximately 30 years. He retired in 2004 at which time he was a professor in the College of Applied Science and Technology, Allied Health program. Dr. Stockham prepared the proposal for a Bachelor of Science in Health Services Management program and was instrumental in developing the curriculum for the Allied Health program. Ed Stockham was the Allied Health Education Grant Principal Investigator.
