Slide 1 – Spirit on his back playing with a student while two handlers hold his leashes.

Slide2 – Spirit chews on a sneaker while two handlers hold his leashes and children look on.

Slide 3 – Spirit walks outside at night while two handlers lead him. (or he leads them)

Slide 4 – Spirit chews on a sneaker while a female student pets him and two handlers hold his leashes.

Slide 5 – Spirit sits on the floor with his sneaker in his paws while two handlers hold his leashes.

Slide 6 – Spirit chews on his sneaker as handler Dave Page pets him.

Slide 7 – Spirit plays on his back on the gym floor while two handlers hold his leashes.
